Opening Keynote Plenary Session

Genevieve Cullen, President of the World Electric Vehicle Association (WEVA) and U.S. based Electric Drive Transportation Association (EDTA) will officially open the 29th International Electric Vehicle Symposium (EVS29) in Montréal, Québec, welcoming policy and industry leaders from around the world.

Co-host Electric Mobility Canada will be featured, and key policymakers from Canada and the US, and prominent leaders from the electric drive industry, including Hydro-Québec President and CEO Éric Martel, will deliver keynote remarks on the future of electric drive.

On day two, Pierre-Luc Desgagné, Vice President – Corporate Affairs and Secretary General at Hydro-Québec will provide critical insights on electrified transportation in Canada.

EVS29 will close with Presidents of EDTA, AVERE and EVAAP honoring the E-Visionaries from North American, European, and Asia Pacific regions, awarding trailblazers for promotion of electric drive communities across the globe.

Delegates will also enjoy a recap of the three-day gathering in Montréal and closing remarks from event hosts.

The EVS baton will be officially passed to AVERE President Joeri de Ridder, who will officially announce the EVS30 European host city.

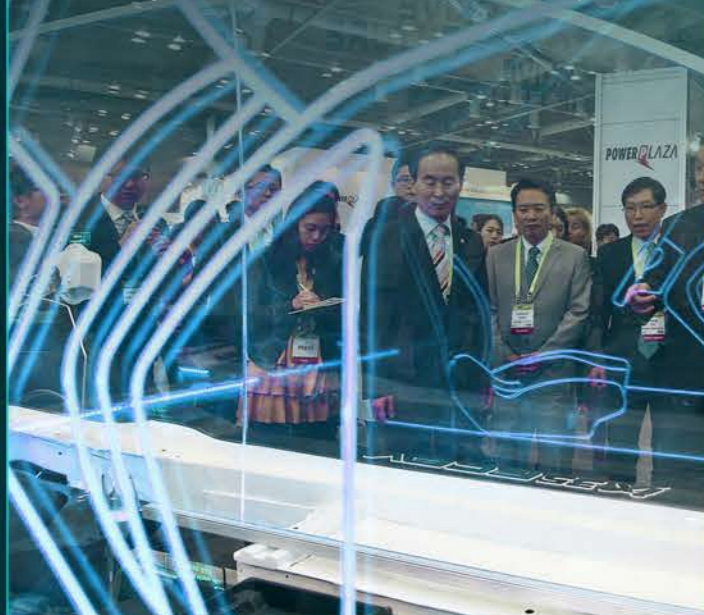
